## *Montell's Olympic venture- (i). Qualification July 11/18th*

Montell Douglas has joined the ranks of Heathers past and present who have attained Olympian status. At the Aviva National championships and Olympic trials in Birmingham on July 12<sup>th</sup> she finished second to Jeannette Kwakye (in a time of 11.35 just outside the qualifying standard of 11.30secs ) but gained selection for the 4x100m relay squad on the strength of this performance. Then on the following Friday, at Loughborough in the LEAP International Meeting she raised her game to clock 10.95 seconds in her heat. Although the 2.6 metre p/s following wind was over the limit for record purposes, she followed this by winning the event in 11.05 secs and the 2.0 p/s wind was the maximum allowable limit. It gained her selection for an individual place in the 100 metres and broke the long-standing British record of 11.10 seconds, set by Kathy Cook in 1981. To crown a triumphant week Montell graduated in Sports Science from Brunel University, from which coincidentally Kathy was herself a graduate in the 1980s. Montell paid tribute to her coach Ayo Faola whose vision encouraged her to achieve Oltmpic selection. "We have worked so hard .... After the heat, he said I just have to do the same again for the final and I did." On reflecting on her achievement she recalled "My mum said to me 'fly like a bird' and my physio said to me 'run like the wind '.

## (ii) Montell at the Olympics-100 metres.



Montell opened her Olympic experience in the first round heats of the 100metres on the morning of August 16th with a useful performance. Although admittedly nervous she appeared comfortable as she moved to the next round. Using the 'Butler start' with the blocks placed close together, she qualified in second place with a time of 11.36 seconds, maintaining an upright stance assisted by a strong driving action from the arms. Job done and keeping relaxed she moved to the second round to meet Sherine Simpson of Jamaica. This time however despite an almost identical time (11.38) she paced fourth and so did not progress further. The decks would be clear now for the relays.

## (iii) Anticipation and disappointment- The relays

It could have been a famous triumph, marking the rise of a new generation of British sprinters on the world stage, but at the final of the Women's 4x100 metre relays tragedy was to strike cruel fashion. The sprint relay team seemed poised to make its mark in the best way especially after an impressive race in the semi-final as Montell returned to the track for event of her initial selection. Running second leg from Jeannette Kwakye, and passing onto Emily Freeman., she helped provide the impetus to see the team qualify comfortably for the final in second place behind Belgium. Already looking an impressive medal hope, the teams chances were enhanced by a dramatic falter from the U.S team who were eliminated from the event when Lauren Williams amazingly dropped the baton from Toni Edwards.

Before the final itself the team were described in The Independent as '*the ones to deliver the fifth British medal in athletics which would match the traget set by U.K sport..*' and '*the best chance (to win a medal) since the 1980s*' ....and, they were ready. But in the final it was to go frustratingly wrong for the British girls. Initially a strong first leg from Jeannette Kwakye was followed by Montell's equally impressive second leg and the British team were in a medal winning position. But at the second handover Montell slowing down approached Emily Freeman who accelerated before the baton was exchanged. A further attempt at exchange was made but proved unsucsessful, whilst the British girls appeared to be distracted by the Jamaicans running into their lane. The result was that the British girls were unable to complete the handover and were consequently unable to finish the event.

*'We messed up'.... commented Montell afterwards 'I called for her (Emily Freeman's) hand and our timing was out. I was off balance trying to put the baton in her hand .. and when I put it in I knew it wasn't going to get there...she ran away from me'... I looked down at the floor..and shouted '**stop Emily, stop**'. I could see the end of the box . I thought '**don't run out of the box**' but by then it was too late and we couldn't get it in.*

It had all happened so fast. '*It was one of those things...*' reflected Jeanette Kwakye, and Michael Johnson suggested '*in this situation you are more fatigued.. Montell ran a phenomenal backstraight but was deccelearating*'.

An appeal was lodged against the alleged blocking of the lane by the Jamaicans. The grounds for it might well have been used by performance director Dave Collins as an explanation for what had gone wrong but it was not upheld and there was no re-run.

Montell might well be disappointed with her performances here but perhaps this should be a reflection of the high standards she has attained this year and of her enhanced hopes and aspirations for the future.
