From the editor:

PC Tucker's aspirations are well Met this year.

Whilst many club members' attentions were no doubt focused on Olympian activities in Beijing this summer, the achievements of other prominent athletes might in all the excitement and triumph, have easily have been overlooked. Nevertheless readers will have been aware of the continued impressive

performances and form of such athletes especially on the road, and in particular those of Peter Tucker, at club, police and international level.

Having distinguished himself at the London Marathon, as first heathern home in a time of 2 hours 23'12, Peter was selected to run for England in the Scotiabank Toronto Waterfront Marathon in Canada.

Leading up to this he won both the Burnham Beeches Half Marathon in August and the Dorney Lake Windsor 10km in September. Whilst the times in these might have indicated a 2 hours 18 marathon, the Scotiabank race was run in a high quality field and in the unpredictable world of marathon running, he finished 24th with 2 hours 30'35, no doubt invaluable international experience. Recently again he has had high finish placings in Kent, at Whitstable in the Police 10 mile race, and at Ashford

where his second place in the 10km there was his fourth County silver medal this year, adding to those claimed in the 5000 metres, 10 mile and 20 mile races. But if he has himself expressed disappointment with the time of 32'24 for that 10km, it would still reflect the high standards he has set himself, and which have been attained by hard work and the coaching of Gordon Cooper. We can no doubt look forward to greater things to come from one of the Met's finest. WHO.

A scene from last month's European Championship Clubs Cup for Juniors which took place in Mitrovica, Serbia where the junior women competed in the A final. In a high quality field the Blackheath team finished seventh out of the eight teams at this level. A good start saw them in third place after five events, and with successes in the field where five of them won medals, two silver and three bronze. On the track however it was a tougher time with fourth places being the best performances that could be managed. Due to one bizarre oversight by officials Amy De Matos, in the 3000m steeplechase found herself running an additional lap to the standard distance, so no athletes in this event were given times. Although the ladies now have to wait to see which final of this championship they will compete in next year, they have earned the right to represent Britain by being the best team at the National Junior League final at Derby earlier last month. Here victory came at a steady pace. Early success in the field was followed by valuable point scoring in both strings on the track, and then, in a tight contest, a late surge thanks to performances from leading ladies as Shaunagh Brown and Lauren Blackie ensured that a successful defence of the National Junior title was achieved.

Coming soon.... As if running on air

Readers and club members may be interested to know of a recently published book by David Colquhoun entitled "As if running on air". Launched recently at the National Library of New Zealand by Mr Colquhoun, who is curator of manuscripts at the Alexander Turnbull Library there, its subject matter concerns the journals and diaries of New Zealand runner Jack Lovelock, one of the great rivals of Sydney Wooderson, and is an edition of those records that he kept throughout his running career in England. The book explores how Wooderson (as the only man who managed to beat Lovelock more often than he lost to him) was a key factor that shaped the way Lovelock prepared for his greatest race – the Olympic 1500 metres of 1936, where he both won gold and broke the world record. Unless done elsewhere I hope to be featuring a review of this book in the next courier or in the new year.
