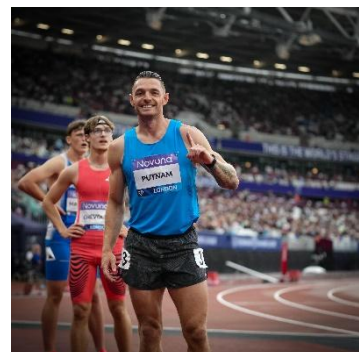

The third and final match of our National Athletics League season was a resounding success. As hosts, we always expected a strong showing, but winning by an 80-point margin was nothing short of dominant. It was a performance that underlined our strength as a club and showcased what we are capable of when firing on all cylinders.

Despite finishing one point shy of qualifying for the promotion final, we can take immense pride in knowing we scored more event points than any other club in our division: 1708 compared to Chelmsford's 1676 and Herts Phoenix's 1659. A fourth-place finish in Match 1 and a loss of officials points in Match 2 (which we still won on the field) ultimately cost us—but the season's overall performance speaks volumes.
